

Adding Widgets to Sidebars

Click Add Block button

Locate and click the Add Block button in the WordPress widget management interface to begin adding new widgets

Choose widget type

Select from available widget types such as Heading or Paragraph from the widget selection panel

Enter your content

Input the desired content for your selected widget in the provided content fields

Position in sidebar area

Drag and position the widget in your desired sidebar area (left or right) to complete the setup

Customizer Real-Time Editing

See changes instantly before publishing

1 Open Customizer under Appearance

Access the WordPress customizer from the admin dashboard under the Appearance menu

2 Navigate to Sidebar Settings

Select the Widgets section to modify sidebar configurations

3 Adjust Widget Placement

Drag and drop widgets between available widget areas

4 Configure Visibility Options

Set display conditions for each widget using the visibility controls

5 Preview Changes Live

View all modifications in real-time without affecting the live site

Keep widgets relevant to content

Quantity

Limit number for clean appearance

Testing


Test on mobile devices

Maintenance

Regular updates and maintenance

Titles

Use descriptive titles for clarity
